BARTON HILLS VILLAGE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Building Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of Barton Hills Village, Washtenaw County, is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Barton Hills Village, Washtenaw County, under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan, Barton Hills Village, Washtenaw County, assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

SECTION 2. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same. This ordinance shall be published in full in the Ann Arbor News, a newspaper of general circulation in Barton Hills Village, within 10 days after its adoption, and shall be effective upon the day following the date of publication.
