

**BARTON HILLS VILLAGE
WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

ORDINANCE NO. 28

[An ordinance to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2 (Public Behavior)]

Barton Hills Village ordains that Section 2 of Ordinance Number 2 be amended to read as follows.

SECTION 2. ACTS PROHIBITED

No person shall:

- (1) Commit an assault, or an assault and battery on any person.
- (2) Be drunk in any public place or under the influence of any narcotic drug in any public place.
- (3) Engage in ~~insulting~~, indecent, ~~immoral~~, or obscene conduct in any public place.
- (4) Discharge any firearm, air rifle, air pistol or bow and arrow in the Village except when lawfully acting in the defense of persons or property or the enforcement of law ~~or at any duly authorized skeet shooting area or target range~~ except pursuant to a permit for eliminating animals causing a nuisance.
- (5) Fire, discharge, display, or possess any fireworks except of the type and under the conditions permitted by Chapter 39 of the Penal Code of the State of Michigan (MCL 750.243a et seq.).
- (6) Engage in peeping in the windows of an inhabited place.
- (7) Beg in any public place.
- (8) ~~Bathe in any body of water in a naked state, or with his or her person so much undressed that there shall be an indecent exposure of the body.~~
- (9 8) Use any indecent, immoral, or insulting language to, or in the presence or hearing of, any other person, or manifest any indecent or insulting behavior in said Village in the presence, view or hearing of any other person. Engage in conduct or communication which, by its very existence, inflicts injury or tends to incite an immediate breach of the peace or which prevents the peaceful and orderly conduct of a public meeting.
- (10 9) Make any ~~immoral exhibition~~ or indecent exposure of his or her person.
- (11 10) Willfully destroy, remove, damage, alter or in any manner deface any property not his own, ~~or any public building, bridge, fire hydrant, alarm box, street light, street sign or traffic control device belonging to the Village or located in the public places of the Village, or mark~~

~~or in any manner mar the walls of any public building, or fence, tree, shrubs, plants or pole within the Village, or destroy, take, or meddle with any property belonging to the Village, or remove the same from the building or place where it may be kept, placed or stored, without proper authority.~~

~~(12) Insult, accost, molest, or otherwise annoy, either by word of mouth, sign, or motion, any person in any public place.~~

~~(1311) Engage in any disturbance, fight, or quarrel in a public place.~~

~~(1412) Loiter on any street or sidewalk or in any park or public building or conduct himself oneself in any public place so as to obstruct the free and uninterrupted passage of the public.~~

~~(1513) Disturb the public peace and quiet by loud, boisterous, or vulgar conduct.~~

~~(1614) Obstruct, resist, hinder, or oppose any member of the Police Department, or any peace officer in the discharge of his duties as such.~~

~~(17) Wander about the streets, either by day or night, or loiter in any public building, without any lawful means of support or without being able to give a satisfactory account of himself.~~

~~(1815) Prowl about the private premises of any other person in the nighttime, without authority or the permission of the owner of such premises.~~

~~(19) Wrongfully throw or propel any snowball, missile or object from any moving motor vehicle.~~

~~(20) Wrongfully throw or propel any snowball, missile or object toward any person or motor vehicle.~~

~~(2116) Summon, as a joke or prank or otherwise without any good reason therefor, by telephone or otherwise, the Police or Fire Department or any public or private ambulance to go to any address where the service called for is not needed.~~

~~(22) Drive or operate any motor vehicle over or upon any private property without the consent of the owner of such private property except at a driveway when entry to such driveway has not been expressly prohibited under section 3 of this ordinance.~~
